5. ALL entries **must** remain on display until 4:00 p.m. Sunday.
6. Quality of workmanship, as well as beauty of the entry will be considered.
7. All entries must meet requirements of category, size, and quantity or they cannot be accepted.
8. The Fair Management will not be responsible for loss or damage to any entry exhibited, but every precaution will be taken for the safekeeping of all entries.
9. Prize money will be awarded immediately after the auction. It can be collected at the Office (S.E. corner of lunch stand).

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE:

Entry Card(s): (See Sample 1)

- ~ Each exhibitor must prepare a 3x5 ruled card with name, address and list of entries.
- ~ Additional cards require only entrant's name at top.
- ~ Use only the front side of the 3 x 5 cards. Do not use back of card.
- ~ List each entry on a separate line, showing name of section, category and class in which it is entered.

Labeling Entries: (See Sample 2)

- ~ Prepare a 1x2 inch card for each entry with the Section, Category and Class.
- ~ Attach the prepared 1x2 inch card to the bottom right of the corresponding entry.

Name/Age Labels: (See Sample 3)

- ~ Prepare self-sticking labels with entrant's name and age or use return address labels with age included. Label is not to exceed 1/2" x 1 3/4 ".

One Bowl Chewy Oreo Brownies

Ingredients:

- ½ cup unsalted butter, melted
- ¾ cup granulated sugar
- ½ cup brown sugar, packed
- 2 eggs, room temperature
- 1 tablespoon oil
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- ¾ cup all-purpose flour
- ½ cup cocoa powder
- ½ teaspoon baking soda
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ cup semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 7 crushed Oreos plus more for garnish

Instructions:

- 1) Preheat oven to 350 F. Grease 8"x8" foil pan.
- 2) In medium bowl, add melted butter, granulated sugar, brown sugar and mix well with whisk.
- 3) Add in eggs one at a time, mixing after each to incorporate.
- 4) Mix in oil and vanilla extract.
- 5) Slowly add flour, cocoa powder, baking soda and salt until batter is well mixed, smooth and all ingredients are well incorporated.
- 6) Stir in chocolate chips and crushed Oreos.
- 7) Add batter to baking pan and top with additional crushed Oreos for garnish.
- 8) Bake for 25 to 30 minutes or until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out just barely clean. Do not overbake.
- 9) Remove brownies from oven and cool on wire rack.
USE FOIL PAN. DO NOT CUT OR REMOVE FROM PAN.
