Pound Cake

Ingredients:

- 2 ¾ cup granulated sugar
- 1 1/4 cup butter
- 5 eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla or other flavoring
- 3 cups flour
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 cup evaporated milk

Instructions:

- 1) Preheat oven to 350 F. Grease and flour a 10"x4" loaf pan or line bottom with parchment paper.
- 2) Beat sugar, butter, eggs and flavoring on low mixer speed for 30 seconds, constantly scraping the bowl. Then beat on high mixer speed for 5 minutes, occasionally scraping the bowl.
- 3) Add flour, baking powder and salt alternately with the evaporated milk on low mixer speed.
- 4) Pour batter into prepared pan.
- 5) Bake 70 to 80 minutes or until a wooden toothpick inserted in center comes out clean.
- 6) Remove from oven and cool for approximately 20 minutes.
- 7) Remove from pan and cool completely on wire rack.
