#### High Point Awards: 15 and Under

1-2-3-4-6-7-9-12-14-15-17-18-19

#### High Point Awards: 16 and Over

1-2-3-5-6-8-9-13-14-16-17-18-19

\$\$\$ Calcutta – The audience bids to own the horse and rider for this event. All money bid is pooled and distributed to the winning "owners" based on placement of the top three horses. First Place receives 50%, Second Place receives 35% and third place receives 15%. The Riders receive trophy and ribbons.

\*\* Walk Trot and Lead Line Classes – Participants in these events are **NOT** eligible for any other performance class. Lead Line riders are **Not Eligible** for Walk Trot Class (11).

### General Guidelines:

- The Horse show is not liable for theft, accident or injury to rider, equipment or horse.
- NO ONE under the age of 18 may show a Stallion
- All contestants must wear proper attire except in classes: 10-20-21-22-23-24. The decision of the judge is final
- FIVE- minute tack change allowed if notified to the announcers booth
- No entries are refunded
- The Show Committee has the right to combine, cancel or divide a class when necessary (3 entries per class minimum)
- The Show Committee has the right to refuse check or issue tabs
- A \$40.00 charge on all returned checks

If you have not been to the Big Rock Plowing Match Horse Show before, we think you are in for a treat!

The Show is designed to be educational, fun and maybe even financially rewarding. Cash awards are given to high point winners and a general drawing at the end of the show for \$100.00 if you placed in any event. You must be available at the end of the show with your ribbon(s) in order to claim your prize. No Stand-ins Please!

Our Judge was selected for the show to help you improve your ride and make sure you are having FUN in the process. You may be in for a surprise in some of the classes.
