- ~ The Big Rock Plowing Match Junior Fair Committee and volunteers will not be responsible for loss or damage to any entry exhibited, but every precaution will be taken for the safekeeping of all entries.

BAKING ENTRIES

- ~ No cream cheese or whip cream frosting.
- ~ Each entry is to be placed on sturdy cardboard or a heavy-duty plate (plastic, paper or foam) and packaged in a large zip closure plastic bag or a foil pan with a clear lid. No plastic wrap or twist ties. Entries not meeting packaging rules will be declined.
- ~ All entries are judged on appearance, texture, taste, moisture and presentation. However, decorated entries are judged primarily on appearance.
- ~ Entries taking 1st or 2nd place will be sold at auction (in container provided) at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday.

Baking Special Entry Recipe – Pumpkin Brownies

Ingredients:

- | | | | |
|---------------------------|--------------------------|------------------------------------|--------------------------|
| • ¾ cup all-purpose flour | • ¾ cup melted butter | • ¼ cup cocoa powder | • ½ cup pumpkin puree |
| • ½ tsp. baking powder | • 1 ½ cup white sugar | • ½ cup semi-sweet chocolate chips | • ¾ tsp. ground cinnamon |
| • ½ tsp. salt | • 2 tsp. vanilla extract | | • ½ tsp. ground cloves |
| | • 3 eggs | | • ½ tsp. ground nutmeg |

Instructions:

- 1) Preheat oven to 350° F. Grease or line with parchment paper an 8x8 baking pan (suggest a foil pan).
- 2) In a bowl, stir together the flour, baking powder and salt.
- 3) In a separate bowl, stir together the melted butter, sugar and vanilla. Using a spoon, mix in eggs one at a time. Gradually stir in the flour mixture from #2 and divide the batter evenly between two separate bowls.
- 4) Stir the cocoa powder and chocolate chips into one bowl of batter.
- 5) Stir the pumpkin puree, cinnamon, cloves and nutmeg into the other bowl of batter.
- 6) Spread half of the chocolate batter from step #4 into the bottom of the greased baking pan, then
- 7) Spread half of the pumpkin batter from step #5 on top of the chocolate batter.
- 8) Add dollops of each of the remaining chocolate and pumpkin batters into the baking pan (this will make it easier to swirl). Then, drag a kitchen knife gently through the batter dollops to create a swirl top.
- 9) Bake for 45 to 48 minutes or until a wooden toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool. **Do not cut.**

~ All entries must be picked up between 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. There is NO early pick up of an entry.

Before You Arrive

- Complete one entry form per entrant (appropriate form for entrant's age).
- Check (✓) the classes entering.
- Complete entry label(s).
~ Prepare a 1" x 2" inch label for each entry with the Class # and description.
~ Attach the prepared 1" x 2" inch label to the bottom right of the corresponding entry.
- Complete entrant label(s).
~ Prepare self-sticking labels with entrant's name, town and age. Label is not to exceed ½" x 1 ¾".
~ Bring these labels with you. One label will be attached to each entry tag.
